





What do you like best about your pet(s)?


Sans has blossomed into a sweet, loving and adorable dog over the years. He was never aggressive but submissive. We know that he is very grateful to us for having rescued him.

Your house has gained a nickname since you've become residents in Cane Island, The Model Airplane Museum. Tell us a little about this:

My wife Susan and I have now lived in Cane Island for 5 years. We sold each of our houses that we had before we met and decided to build a new one with mobility in the future in mind so it's a one story.

Instead of having the designed 3 car garage with one bay having a two-car lengthwise capability, I enclosed the rear bay and made an isolated separate room with air conditioning and running water for a sink that is designed to build model airplanes and restore antiques. My hobby is building and flying completion control lines and free-flight model airplanes and I wanted a year-round room that was isolated from the main house yet accessible without going outside so any paint /glue fumes would stay separate from the living area. We also added a 1/2bay extension to the remaining garage to allow for storage of the over 150 model airplanes I use for competitions and teaching children how to fly.

In this unique area, I decorated the walls and ceilings with some of the models I use in competitions, awards for national and world championships and historical significant antique surfboards I have restored and collected. I have restored over 850 vintage surfboards for both individuals and museums worldwide and still do one occasionally for collectors.

Fortunately, my wife Susan decorated the house which includes a unique display of antique Valentine cards in the dining room and many hand-painted plates, clocks and eggs her mother was quite well known for. Each room in the house has a theme including the office space which displays many of my wife's medals



for marathon and triathlon events she has competed in and won. The house is a museum with two adult kids living in it.

Our inspiration was to display each of our interests tastefully. I may have failed in my shop area as it's now described as the "museum" by all my fellow modelers and surf enthusiasts.

How did you get involved in this hobby?

My model airplane hobby is more of a long lifestyle. At the age of 3, my earliest memory is my father taking me to the local airport and I watched a real small trainer take off and land and airplanes have been my life ever since. I began building/flying models at the age of 6 and it was self-taught by trial and many errors. By the time I was 9, I was building them for other kids and their parents and had developed a neighborhood reputation as the kid to see if you wanted to learn how to fly them. We had a circle in my backyard where I would hold local neighborhood contests. Back in the 1960's modeling was very popular. As a teenager, I was competing nationally as well as learning to fly real airplanes and was the youngest flight instructor in the United States when I turned 18, which was the minimum age. I was hired by the US Navy the day I graduated from high school and was test flying all their new aircraft at Patuxent Naval Air Test Center where the Navy does all their new aircraft testing. I continued to build models my whole career as well as restore vintage real airplanes and fly them all over the country. I retired as the chief scientist and executive Director of the Air Force Cryptologic Systems Center in San Antonio as I ended up flight testing for the Air Force at Kelly AFB and moved into cryptography.

We heard that this has become a family affair. Share some of the background on this:

My son took up flying models and was a member of the Junior World Championship free flight team which won in 1990 he won the Ukrainian national championship in 1994 as well as numerous national championships and broke many national and world records. After he went off to college, I continued to fly free-flight model airplanes and was inducted into the National Free Flight Hall of Fame in 2012.

Are you currently doing anything that could get the younger people in Cane Island who may be interested in model airplanes involved with this hobby as well?

This hobby can teach a young person skills in engineering, wood and metal construction techniques and meteorology. I build and fly models out at Scobee Field in George Bush Park here in Katy and continue to compete and build for myself and many others. I have supported the US Junior World Championship free flight teams for many years and acted as the coach in 1992 and 1994. I have taught many young people how to fly the control line and free flight models and keep a couple of trainers in case anyone wishes to learn young and old.

What has been your favorite moment or biggest takeaway from this hobby?

My favorite modeling memory was when my son at the age of 13 won the junior F1C world championship in Yugoslavia. The USA team had never won anything up till that time and as they played the Star Spangled Banner and raised the US flag behind him it was a very special moment for me. He and I traveled the world flying models and he opened his eyes to a world much bigger than Seguin Tex. I also got to watch him grow as both a modeler and a person. He now is the librarian at Nottingham Country Elementary and his two daughters are in the gifted student programs there. Both of my granddaughters have built and flown their own models, so the legacy continues. In this day of instant entertainment, seeing a young person have the desire and do the work to make a complex model fly well is becoming a lost art. I am fortunate to have a family that still appreciates craftsmanship and the work it takes to achieve it.

- Filling3/4 cup (11/2 sticks) unsalted butter. at room temperature
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- 2 1/2 cups powdered sugar
- 1 tablespoon milk


1. Preheat the oven to 375°F. Line three large baking sheets with parchment paper. 2. In a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, cream the butter, brown sugar, and granulated sugar on medium speed until light and fluffy, about 2 minutes. Slowly add the egg, vanilla, and molasses and mix until smooth, scraping down the sides as needed. 3. In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, and oats until combined. On low speed,

5. Refrigerate the baking sheets for at least 20 minutes. 6. One sheet at a time. bake the cookies until lightly golden, 10 to 12 minutes. Let the cookies cool on the baking sheet placed on top of a wire rack for 30 minutes. 7. In a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, cream the butter on high speed until light and fluffy, 3 to 4 minutes. Beat in the vanilla. 8. On low speed, slowly beat in the powdered sugar, about 1/4 cup at a time. Then beat in the milk. When the mixture is smooth, increase the speed to medium, mixing until thoroughly combined and fluffy, about 2 minutes. 9. Lay out the cookies in pairs, flipping one of each face-up. Using a small (1-tablespoon) scoop, place the filling on the bottom of the upsidedown cookie. Place the second cookie on top, right side up, and sandwich them together, pressing just enough to spread the filling to the edges. Repeat to make the rest of the sandwiches.




