



# CANE ISLAND HOA MESSAGE BEST WISHES FOR THE NEW SCHOOL YEAR

hether you're ready or not, books, friends, activities, and traffic are just around the corner. With school starting, it is only fitting that August is National Backto-School Month! This tradition has been observed since the early 1960s throughout the United States. It's time to dust off the backpacks, fill them up, and plan for a new school year.

With kids in school buses, children on foot and bikes, hurried parents in cars: Back-to-school days bring congestion – and an increase in potential hazards.

Fortunately, a few key tips can help improve safety for everyone. Here are some recommendations that drivers should be aware of, as well as some reminders for parents to share with their kids.

- Slow down and drive extra cautiously.
- Don't load or unload children across the street from the school.
- When flashers are blinking, stop and yield to pedestrians crossing the crosswalk or intersection.
- Be prepared for kids to appear in unexpected places, like from between parked cars; if they're on bikes, prepare for them to turn in front of you without looking or signaling.
- If you need to use your phone, be sure you're pulled over safely.
- Watch for kids walking while looking at their phones.

• Don't ever block a crosswalk; it forces pedestrians to go around you and could put them in the path of moving traffic.

# Eye Emergencies

For my Doctor's Note article in the July issue of Stroll, I discussed managing your own common eye issues. This time I will describe more urgent eye conditions.

- 1/Red, painful eye if the pain is mild and you improve with the initial use of artificial tears, it is most likely just surface irritation. However, if the pain is severe, vision is affected, and especially if you are a contact lens wearer, you should be seen to rule out corneal ulcers.
- 2/Styes 90% of your small styes will resolve by just using a warm compress and massaging toward the lid margin. If the stye does not get smaller within a week or if you start getting progressive redness and swelling around the eyelids you may need antibiotics or actual drainage of the stye.
- 3 / Progressively increasing severe pain in the eye associated with reduced vision, nausea, redness, halos around lights, and tenderness to the touch - this could be angle closure glaucoma and needs to be addressed emergently. Most glaucoma is not painful and patients are unaware of an elevated pressure but the acute severe rise in glaucoma is very painful and vision threatening.
- 4 / Sudden onset of a lot of floaters (particles in your vision) with or without flashing lights when you move your eye - 90% of the time, flashes and floaters is just a vitreous detachment and not a retinal detachment. As we age, the gel or vitreous within the eye becomes less firm. Small particles that look like lint are floaters and are normal but if the gel separates from the wall of the eye suddenly, it can cause a retinal tear that requires laser treatment. If you do not observe any vision loss, you can be seen for a dilated retinal exam within 1-3 days. If you see an area of shadowy vision or peripheral blind spot, this could be a retinal detachment and you should be seen emergently.
- 5 / Sudden vision loss of any kind should be addressed as soon as possible by the eye care specialist. ER doctors may not have the equipment needed to evaluate the problem.
- 6 / Trauma to the eye if vision is good and there are no obvious anatomical changes, an eye exam within a few weeks of direct eye trauma is advisable. If you have a change in vision, visible swelling, or distortion of the pupil, this could indicate more significant damage.






